GREAT BRITAIN BY NIGHT

As the notable kindred of Great Britain are no doubt aware, the domain of Suffolk no longer exists. Prince Carter Branch of Clan Malkavian has relinquished his claim of domain and acknowledged Queen Anne Bowesley to be ruler of Suffolk. Queen Anne's domain of London is now, without a doubt, the most populous in terms of both mortals and kindred in the UK. Indeed she holds almost the entire south east in her grasp.

There has been no evidence of coercion in this merger, and no transfer of prestation between Branch and Queen Anne. However, Branch now sits as one of the primogeniture in London. ABDUCTION CASE HAS BAFFLED POLICE

The confirmation that the remains of a missing Glasgow accountant have been discovered in the Firth of Clyde has come as a shock to detectives working on a case that has been shrouded in mystery.

When fishermen made the gruesome find of a human skull in their nets off the island of Little Cumbrae last month, the friends and family of Andrew Ramsay were still clinging to the hope that he may still have been alive.

It is unclear how much the discovery will reveal about what happened after the father-of-two was abducted by two men posing as policemen in February 2006.

The case has left Strathclyde Police baffled and frustrated. It has led to a number of theories ranging from alleged sightings abroad to stories that his abduction may have been staged.

The only person to witness what happened to him on the evening of Wednesday 22 February was his girlfriend of eight months, Beverley Sinclair.

Mr Ramsay, who would have been 53 in March this year, was handcuffed and bundled into a car by two men claiming to be police officers outside his home in Berryknowes Road, Cardonald.

Police investigation

The couple were returning from the nearby Quo Vadis pub in Paisley Road West which they left

shortly after 1900 GMT.

They then stopped at an off-license before walking towards their home.

The two men used what appeared to be police ID as they took Mr Ramsay, a keen hillwalker who had been unemployed for six months.

Despite a huge international police investigation officers struggled to find out what had happened to him.

Detectives pursued more than 1,000 lines of inquiry, interviewed more than 1,000 people and took more than 300 statements.

The hunt also took detectives to cities in England, Wales, Northern Ireland and Belgium to visit the accountant's associates.

Shortly after the abduction Mr Ramsay's brother Stewart made an emotional appeal for information.

The abduction was also reconstructed for the BBC's Crimewatch programme and an appeal was made at a Rangers football match. A £5,000 reward was also offered for information.

Unconfirmed reports of sightings in the UK and abroad also proved fruitless and a year on, the lack of progress led the officer leading the inquiry, Det Supt Willie Prendergast, to describe the case as "one of the most frustrating I have dealt with".

GLASGOW AIRPORT GETS £30M INVESTMENT

Airport operator BAA Glasgow has announced plans to redevelop Glasgow airport.

The firm is to inject £30m into the project with the aim of increasing capacity, reducing security waiting times and offering better services for customers.

The project, which is named skyhub, includes the introduction of new retail and catering facilities and is due to begin this month, with officials saying that the work will continue for a further 18 months.

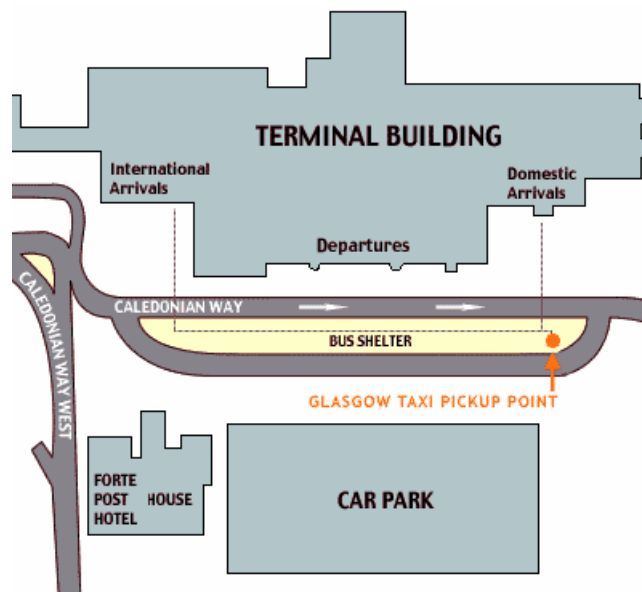
Glasgow airport will soon have just one large security area which will be positioned on the first floor, replacing the three separate areas which are currently in place.

BAA Glasgow is confident that this will speed up the security-checks process, as will the four additional x-ray machines that will be put in place.

'Security, for any airport, is of paramount importance and as passenger numbers increase, it's important that we are able to screen passengers quickly and safely,' said Gordon Dewar, managing director at the hub.

'We have already announced a major investment in additional staff and x-ray technology. skyhub takes that investment a step further and will give us the flexibility and the extra capacity that we need to provide a fast, efficient security screening service.'

'Our aim, ultimately, will be to reduce the amount of time passengers wait in security lines and, in the process, deliver a better customer experience for our growing number of passengers,' he added.
