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Gangster's Bloodbath

On the 13th of January, just after midnight, a quiet area of Shawlands was rocked by an incident more in character for South Central Los Angeles. In a prolonged outburst of automatic gunfire, a black limousine containing 5 adult men was riddled with bullet holes in a multi-storey car park, killing all the occupants, including an infamous Russian gangster, Arcady Borovich.

Responding to reports, the police were wary of approaching the area without armed back-up, and it was around 30 minutes before they arrived on the scene. By that time, there was no sign of the attackers, while the attending paramedics declared each of the men dead at the scene. The men were examined by the coroner, who found that each of the victims was covered in blood, but which had come from only 4 of the bodies. Police currently believe that the fifth, Mr Borovich, was killed earlier, and his body was being moved by the men found in the car with him. This has lead the police to attribute the incident to a revenge killing, by some of Mr Borovich's comrades.

Arcady Borovich, also known by the pseudonym "the Butcher of Krasnodar," was wanted by Russian authorities in connection with an extensive list of crimes including murder, corruption, organised crime and even potential war crimes dating back to the 1990s in Chechnya. Mr Borovich is believed to have moved his operation to the UK in recent months to evade their

attentions. It is expected that Russian authorities will ask for the return of his body from its current repose in Glasgow City Morgue.

Efforts are ongoing to ascertain the identities of the attackers. Although there are no witnesses, hundreds of bullet casings were recovered from the scene, and are currently being analysed by forensic firearms experts. Graham Meldrum, head of the Glasgow serious crime unit gave the following statement later on the 13th of January:

"This is a shocking and disturbing incident, and one which we are treating as a top priority. We will be devoting ourselves to identifying and incarcerating those individuals who would seek to turn Glasgow into a warzone and threaten its residents."



Notorious Elder destroyed?

The Dark Times has learned of another attack upon an Elder of the Camarilla, which occurred on the evening of the 25th of January, this incident involving the beleaguered Duchess Isabella Montague. The

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Duchess had just arrived at the Royal Museum of Scotland, to attend a small gathering of Kindred, when her limousine was ambushed. Eye witnesses observed a black van draw alongside the Duchess' car, and opened fire on it with large caliber weapons, in a manner very similar to the attack upon Arcady Borovich.

Following the gunfire, an incendiary device was thrown into the car, which was engulfed in fire, and left a smouldering wreck by the time the fire brigade were able to extinguish the blaze. No sign of the Duchess was found, and none of the eye witnesses observed her escape the vehicle, although the veracity of their testimony may be questionable; prolonged gunfire is a very rare and terrifying occurrence to the residents of Edinburgh. Although Dark Times sources believe the Duchess to have perished, there is a possibility that she escaped, or even that the attack was staged to allow her to disappear.

Police efforts are ongoing to trace the black van, which sped from the scene, and was captured on numerous traffic cameras throughout the city. A spokesman for Lothian and Borders Police released a statement denying that there was any connection with the attack upon Borovich in Glasgow, claiming that there was no reason to think the incidents were linked.

In recent months, the Duchess has come under attack for her suspected part in the assassination attempt upon Viscount Aldworth, who was left torpored by the traitor Magnar Ulrichson. However, no matter the allegations regarding her conduct, she remains for the moment a Camarilla Elder, and it is most worrying that an attack was so brazenly launched against her.

Third Elder hit in two weeks
