### <u>Tragedy ignites social care controversy</u> (Outer Hebrides News)

A joint investigation by police and healthcare officials is underway at private social care company Tranquil Vale, headquartered in Tobermory, Mull. It has emerged that all communication with sheltered housing on an otherwise-uninhabited island off the coast of Benbecula Island abruptly ceased several weeks ago. Staff at Tranquil Vale had insisted to concerned relatives that the blackout was temporary and blamed the problems on storms battering the remote island, which lies between North & South Uist. As more information has emerged and the full scale of the tragedy has come to light, questions are being asked about whether staff at the care provider knew more and were attempting a cover-up. Multiple employees have been suspended, and there is a real possibility that charges of corporate manslaughter will be filed.

The following report contains details that some readers may find distressing.

Emergency services were dispatched from Oban after eyewitnesses called to report seeing a raging fire on the island. On making landfall the following day with the assistance of coastguards from the Isle of Skye, the fire services discovered that Tranquil Vale's property 'Taigh Mairead' was still ablaze, and it was unsafe to attempt to enter; with a second property on the island also having been destroyed by fire. On eventual entry, the heavily charred remains of inhabitants and staff were found still in their beds, with no survivors. Initial investigations have led the police to conclude that all had been dead for several weeks prior to the fire – and carbon monoxide poisoning has been listed as the cause of death.

At this time, the fire at Taigh Mairead is believed to have started accidentally following sparks carried from an explosion at the second property – but the possibility of arson at Taigh Mairead leading to the explosion at the other property has not been discounted. An insider at Tranquil Vale spoke to our reporter off the record, and outlined a history of cost-cutting with safety checks being consistently rescheduled and delayed.

The explosion at the second property will also raise further questions about more general mental health support services on the island, regardless of which fire caused the other:- it appears that a paranoid 'prepper' recluse had taken possession of an abandoned cottage and had been storing large quantities of fuel in a home-constructed tank built into the roof space. Firefighters attending the scene colourfully described the perhaps-inevitable result using phrases that this reporter feels it would be inappropriate to print. Local rumours that this was a 'meth lab' remain unsubstantiated at this time.
