<u>The ancient and venerable sport of</u> <u>Beast-baiting</u>

Note: Naturally, I am writing this as a mere armchair commentator – like others, I eagerly await the return of Mr Ortega's formal Harpy column to read truly biting social critique. But, whilst he is retrieving his pen from whatever bottomless crevasse it fell into, I thought I would offer some brief musings.

For reasons which I shall not disclose, the sport of Beast-baiting recently came to mind. Not, I would assure the animal lovers amongst you, the baiting of bears or setting of dogs or cockerels against one another – but the baiting of the Beast within all of us.

This sport can be being played with many levels of subtlety and intent – and I would strongly recommend learning to recognise it. Young kindred may well not even recognise that they have engaged in this aspect of the great game – merely that they have driven another into rage, and they and their opponent must each navigate the consequences of that.

With a wholly predictable directness, the Anarchs consider it the height of political finesse to deliberately attempt to antagonise elders of the Camarilla into frenzy – ideally in court to maximise the elder's public humiliation and subsequent disgrace. In the interests of keeping language current, my childer advise me this tactic may be compared to 'trolling' amongst the kine upon the internet – and indeed that younger kindred might recognise the unhappy condition that the target finds themselves in as 'being triggered'.

Most established kindred, rightly, scoff at such crude tactics – and whilst nobody except the kindred who frenzies can be held responsible for that loss of control – one who is perceived to have transformed another into a weapon (in both the classical sense and in the Glaswegian vernacular) may well find their own reputation tarnished as a result, for it suggests a lack of judgement.

Instead, the game is played one degree removed. A wise kindred will remove themselves from a source of excessive frustration before they disgrace themselves – but by doing so, they admit their need to retreat. Just as being placed into 'check' does not end a game of chess, but instead admits a position of weakness, so do kindred more subtly indicate that they have been outmatched. A rapid exit, an overly-loud setting down of a glass, an abrupt change of topic – all of these can indicate that unwritten but always-noted points have been scored. However, one may sometimes – shockingly - observe such uncivil behaviour as snarling or the flipping of furniture. Such things are remembered by the Harpies.

But the methods of testing another's resolve and control can vary wildly. A knowingly incorrect form of address used in a most charming invitation, the subtext of an outwardly thoughtful gift, an obsequiously polite suggestion, a minor matter of local housekeeping – each of them a fresh gambit. And these too are noted – often with a discreet figurative golf-clap.

STORYTELLERS ANNOUNCEMENTS

We've been getting some feedback about orders and plots and I want to remind players that it's best practice to take a reread through your previous orders before submitting new ones and to reread responses just before game. We have a high number of players getting disatisfied with orders responses due to misinformation and lack of communication between players. While this can obviously happen for plot reasons at the scale that it is happening, it's clear that quite a few are just simple mistakes. But sometimes those mistakes can lead someone on a wild goose chase to the opposite side of the country and waste several order points.

If this is something you are doing for plot then we would appreciate a heads up where possible so that we can manage player expectations about what type of plot they are engaging in and so we can better tailor order responses rather than just responding with further confusion.

If you are unable to join a plot line or if you are unsure if your participation in a plot requires orders then please reach out to ask us.

Susan will be running Order info sessions from 8:30pm on the 10th, 14th and 17th of September to answer questions and provide some guidance on how to write and get the most out of your orders.

We do have a template in the player handbook which helps players to keep track of what needs to go into orders and will become useful the longer you are in play to communicate boons, IC chats and trackers for progress towards backgrounds. On that note I would like to reiterate to new players that we also have guidance on In Character chats which often take place over social media during the month, in the player handbook but to cover the basics:

If the STs do not know about it, it did not happen. Confirmation needs to come from all players involved.

No player should engage in any discipline rolls, frenzy checks or rotschecks without an ST present. IC chats are there to enhance gameplay, not to replace it.

Consent forms are available in the player handbook and should ideally be exchanged before engaging in any action heavy IC chats to encourage communication about boundaries and expectations. If these are not completed and exchanged, there is also the option of saying "X-Card" to put a stop to any interaction between the players involved.
